WHO NEEDS RYLA?

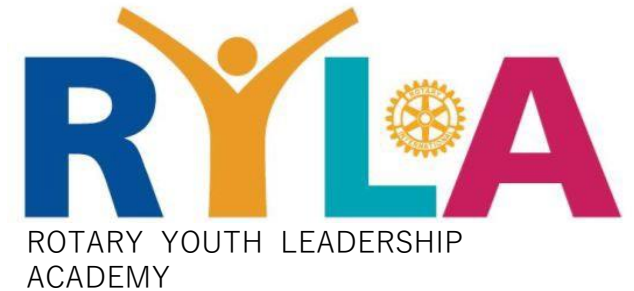
